BY-LAW No. 733-2002

To amend further By-law No. 34-93, a By-law “To provide for disabled person parking permit holders”, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule “E” of By-law No. 34-93, entitled “To provide for disabled person parking permit holders”, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Times or Days)
Woodmount Avenue	West	A point 11.5 metres south of Sammon Avenue and a point 5.5. metres further south	Anytime, January, February, March, April, June, August, October and December

2. This By-law shall come into force on the date of its enactment.
