AMENDMENT NO. 1088 TO THE OFFICIAL PLAN
OF THE FORMER CITY OF SCARBOROUGH
10126 SHEPPARD AVENUE EAST

The following Text and Map, designated as Schedule “T”, constitute Amendment No. 1088 to the Official Plan for the former City of Scarborough (being an amendment to the provisions of the Scarborough Official Plan, Secondary Plan for the Rouge Community Secondary Plan).

The sections headed “Purpose and Location” and “Basis” are explanatory only, and shall not constitute part of this amendment.

PURPOSE AND LOCATION:

This amendment affects land at 10126 Sheppard Avenue East. This amendment provides for Residential Care Facility use in addition to **Executive Residential** use.

BASIS:

The amendment expands the range of uses on the subject site.

OFFICIAL PLAN AMENDMENT:

The Rouge Community Secondary Plan, Figure 4.26, is amended for the land at the municipal address No. 10126 Sheppard Avenue East by adding the Numbered Policy No. 19, as follows:

19. 10126 Sheppard Avenue East

The following use shall be permitted as an alternative to **Executive Residential** use

- Residential Care Facility
