WHEREAS authority is given to Council by Section 34 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13, as amended, to pass this By-law; and whereas Council of the City of Toronto has provided adequate information to the public and has held at least one public meeting in accordance with the *Planning Act*;


The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. Schedule "C", **EXCEPTIONS LIST**, is amended by adding the following Exception No. 35 to lands shown on Schedule '1':
  - 35. (a) Only the following uses shall be permitted
    - Correctional Group Homes
    - Group Homes
      - Single Family Dwellings
    - **Residential Care Facility**
    - (b) Notwithstanding the definition of **Residential Care Facility** contained in Clause IV, **Residential Care Facility** shall be limited to the accommodation of a maximum of thirteen persons, exclusive of staff.
