## BY-LAW No. 766-2002

# To amend Scarborough Zoning By-law No. 12466, as amended, with respect to the L'Amoreaux Community.

WHEREAS authority is given to Council by Section 34 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13, as amended, to pass this By-law; and whereas Council of the City of Toronto has provided adequate information to the public and has held at least one public meeting in accordance with the *Planning Act*;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. The L'Amoreaux Community Zoning By-law No. 12466 is amended as follows:
  - (a) Schedule "1" is amended, with respect to the lands shown outlined, by deleting the current zoning and substituting the following zoning as shown on Schedule '1':

NC-67-108-150-314

- (b) Schedule "B", **PERFORMANCE STANDARDS CHART**, is amended as follows:
  - (i) Adding the following Performance Standard(s):

### **INTENSITY OF USE**

314. Gross floor area of Restaurants shall not exceed 173 m<sup>2</sup>.

### **MISCELLANEOUS**

108. Minimum 7.5 m side and rear yard setback.

- (c) Schedule "C" **EXCEPTIONS LIST**, is amended as follows:
  - (i) Amending Exception No. 46 by deleting the word "Restaurants" from Subsection (c).
  - (ii) Amending Exception No. 46 by adding the following subsection:
- (d) Notwithstanding (c) a minimum 9.8 spaces per 100 m<sup>2</sup> of gross floor area for restaurants shall be provided.


