CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 835-2002

To confirm the level of prescription drug coverage for retirees of the former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto over the age of 65 who retired on or after January 1, 1989.

WHEREAS the Council of the former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto, at its meeting of May, 1990, adopted as amended Clause No. 1 of Management Committee Report No. 16, which action was adopted, ratified and confirmed by Metro By-law No. 48-90; and

WHEREAS Council now wishes to confirm its intention to continue with the provision of prescription drug coverage to retirees of the former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto over the age of 65 who retired on or after January 1, 1989, at the same levels as approved previously by Metro Council;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Employees of the former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto, who retired on or after January 1, 1989 shall, upon reaching the age of 65, continue to receive coverage only for drugs prescribed outside of the Province of Ontario.
2. For greater certainty, this coverage shall not include drugs prescribed within the Province of Ontario.
