BY-LAW No. 871-2002

**To amend further Metropolitan Toronto By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation of
traffic on former Metropolitan Roads.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule XIII (One-Way Traffic Lanes) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by striking out the words and figures:
