BY-LAW No. 877-2002

**To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 400, Traffic and Parking,
respecting Garden Avenue, St. Clarens Avenue and St. John's Road.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, of the former City of Toronto is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule XXXVIII (Designated On-Street Parking for Disabled Person Parking Permit Holders) in § 400-91, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1)	(From Column 2)	(From Column 3)	(From Column 4)
St. Clarens Avenue	East	A point 51.2 metres south of College Street and a point 5.5 metres further south thereof	Anytime
St. John's Road	South	A point 60.6 metres east of Runnymede Road and a point 5.5 metres further east thereof	Anytime

B. By inserting in Schedule XXXVIII (Designated On-Street Parking for Disabled Person Parking Permit Holders) in § 400-91, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Garden Avenue	South	A point 22.0 metres west of Roncesvalles Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further west	Anytime
