BY-LAW No. 887-2002

**To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 400, Traffic and Parking,
respecting Carlton Street.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, of the former City of Toronto is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Part A of Schedule XXVI (Permit Parking) in § 400-79 the following in alphabetical order by street name:

Carlton Street	Odd	From Dermott Place to Riverdale Park Road	61	All times, except no parking 8.30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Mon. to Fri., between a point 35.1 metres east of Sackville Street to Sumach Street

B. By inserting in Part A of Schedule XXVI (Permit Parking) in § 400-79 the following in alphabetical order by street name:

Carlton Street	Odd	From Woodstock Place to the eastern end of Carlton Street	42	All times, except no parking 8:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Mon. to Fri., between a point 35.1 metres east of Sackville Street to Sumach Street

C. By inserting in Part P of Schedule XXVI (Permit Parking) in § 400-79 the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)	(In Column 5)
Carlton Street	Odd	From Dermott Place to Woodstock Place	22	All times, except no parking 8:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Mon. to Fri., between a point 35.1 metres east of Sackville Street to Sumach Street
