BY-LAW No. 901-2002

To layout and dedicate certain land for public lane purposes to form part of the public lane west of Bathurst Street extending northerly from Alcina Street.

WHEREAS the City is the owner of certain land acquired as a condition of the Consent Decision respecting the development of 1366 Bathurst Street;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land to form part of the public lane west of Bathurst Street extending northerly from Alcina Street, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

PIN 21261-0222(LT).

Parts of Lots 1, 2, 3 and 4 on Plan M-133 designated as PART 9 on Plan 66R-19187 in the Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66) in City of Toronto and Province of Ontario is laid out and dedicated for public lane purposes.
