BY-LAW No. 911-2002

To authorize the alteration of Earl Street between Huntley Street and Sherbourne Street by the narrowing of the pavement on the south side of Earl Street east of Huntley Street and widening of the boulevard area.

WHEREAS notice of a proposed By-law regarding the alteration of Earl Street between Huntley Street and Sherbourne Street by the narrowing of the pavement on the south side of Earl Street east of Huntley Street and widening of the boulevard area was published in a daily newspaper on September 23, September 30, October 7 and October 14, 2002 and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on October 15, 2002 and it is appropriate to permit the alteration;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The following alteration is authorized:

The narrowing of the pavement from a width of 8.5 metres to a width of 7.0 metres on the south side of Earl Street, from a point 34.0 metres east of Huntley Street to a point 30.0 metres further east, generally as shown on Drawing No. 42IF-6534, dated June, 2002.
