BY-LAW No. 912-2002

To authorize the alteration of Delaware Avenue between Hallam Street and Dupont Street by the narrowing of the pavement on the east side and widening of the boulevard.

WHEREAS notice of a proposed By-law regarding the alteration of Delaware Avenue between Hallam Street and Dupont Street by the narrowing of the pavement on the east side and widening of the boulevard to allow for landscaping/tree planting on this portion of the Garrison Creek Walkway was published in a daily newspaper on September 23, September 30, October 7 and October 14, 2002 and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on October 15, 2002 and it is appropriate to permit the alteration;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The following alteration is authorized:

The narrowing of the pavement from a width of 7.3 metres to a width of 6.3 metres on the east side of Delaware Avenue, from Hallam Street to Dupont Street, generally as shown on Drawing No. 421F-6466, dated April, 2002.
