BY-LAW No. 1000-2002

To amend By-law No. 2958-94 of the former City of York, being a By-law “To regulate traffic on City of York Roads”.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

RESTRICTED WIDTH OF VEHICLES ON HIGHWAYS - SCHEDULE III

1. That Schedule III of former City of York By-law No. 2958-94, as amended, be further amended by inserting in Columns 1, 2 and 3, of said Schedule the following:

<u>Column 1</u> <u>Highway</u>	<u>Column 2</u> <u>Between</u>	<u>Column 3</u> <u>Vehicle Width (metres)</u>
Lane, first east of Jane Street	Montye Avenue and the easterly terminus of lane	2.0
