BY-LAW No. 1007-2002

To amend By-law No. 196-84 of the former City of York, being a By-law “To regulate traffic on City of York Roads”.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

NO PARKING - SCHEDULE VIII

1. That Schedule VIII of former City of York By-law No. 196-84, as amended, be further amended by inserting in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of said Schedule the following:

| <u>Column 1</u> <u>Highway</u> | <u>Column 2</u> <u>Side</u> | <u>Column 3</u> <u>Between</u> | <u>Column 4</u> <u>Prohibited</u> <u>Times or Days</u> |
|-----------------------------------|--------------------------------|---|--|
| Greendale Avenue | East | A point 68 metres north of Caesar Avenue and a point 5.5 metres north thereof | Anytime |
| Greendale Avenue | West | A point 66.5 metres north of Caesar Avenue and a point 5.5 metres north thereof | Anytime |
