BY-LAW No. 1022-2002

To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 194, Footpaths, Bicycle Lanes and Pedestrian Ways, to establish bicycle lanes on Fort York Boulevard.

Whereas notice of the proposed by-law was published in a daily newspaper on October 21, October 28, November 4 and November 11, 2002 and interested parties were given an opportunity to be heard at a the public meeting held on November 12, 2002;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 194, Footpaths, Bicycle Lanes and Pedestrian Ways, of the former City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended as follows:

A. By adding in alphabetical order to the list of bicycle lanes in § 194-6A the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)
Fort York Boulevard	North and west sides, adjacent to curb	Bathurst Street and Fleet Street
Fort York Boulevard	South and east sides, adjacent to curb	Lake Shore Boulevard West and Bathurst Street
