CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 1031-2002

To amend Municipal Code Chapter 223, Remuneration for Council Members, to reflect the termination of the one third expense allowance under the *Municipal Act*, 2001.

WHEREAS in the *Municipal Act*, 2001, the authority to pay remuneration to members of Council is found in section 8, as interpreted under section 9, and is subject to the limitations in section 283;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 223, Remuneration for Council Members, of the City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended by deleting §§ 223-1, 233-2 and 223-3 and substituting the following:

§ 223-1. Payment of remuneration to Mayor.

For the period of January 1, 2003 to December 31, 2003, the Mayor shall be paid remuneration at the rate of \$139,197.90 per year.

§ 223-2. Payment of remuneration to members of Council.

For the period of January 1, 2003 to December 31, 2003, each member of Council, other than the Mayor, shall be paid remuneration at the rate of \$82,097.64 per year.

§ 223-3. Annual increase.

In the years following 2003, the remuneration paid to the Mayor and the other members of Council shall be increased annually on January 1 of the year by the increase in the Toronto Consumer Price Index, as determined by Statistics Canada.

2. This by-law comes into force on January 1, 2003.
