BY-LAW No. 1069-2002

To layout and dedicate certain land for public lane purposes to form part of the public lane north of Queen Street East extending from Rainsford Road to Woodbine Avenue.

Part of Lot 26 on Plan 816 designated as PART 2 on Plan 66R-19467 in the Registry Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66) in City of Toronto and Province of Ontario is laid out and dedicated for public lane purposes.
