
The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:


- **1.** Chapter 658, Ravine Protection, of the City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended as follows:

 - B. By deleting Schedule A at the end of Chapter 658 and substituting Schedule A attached to this by-law.




