CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 1082-2002

To adopt a new Official Plan for the City of Toronto and repeal the Official Plans for the former municipalities of Metropolitan Toronto, Etobicoke, York, North York, Toronto, East York and Scarborough.

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Toronto proposes to adopt a new Official Plan for the City of Toronto, and to repeal the Official Plans for the former municipalities of Metropolitan Toronto, Etobicoke, York, North York, Toronto, East York and Scarborough; and

WHEREAS the Planning and Transportation Committee conducted a public meeting under Section 17 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990 c.P. 13, as amended, respecting the proposed new City of Toronto Official Plan and the repeal of the existing Official Plans in effect for the City of Toronto; and

WHEREAS City Council at its meeting of October 29, 30 and 31, 2002, decided to adopt the proposed new City of Toronto Official Plan (dated May 2002), as revised, and to repeal the existing Official Plans in effect for the City of Toronto:

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The City of Toronto Official Plan attached hereto as Schedule "A" is hereby adopted.
2. The Official Plans for the former municipalities of Metropolitan Toronto, Etobicoke, York, North York, Toronto, East York and Scarborough, and all subsequent amendments thereto, are hereby repealed.
3. That Section 2 of this By-law will not come into force until the date upon which the new Official Plan for the City of Toronto, or any part thereof, first receives approval pursuant to section 17 of the *Planning Act*.
4. Despite Sections 2 and 3, the Official Plans for the former municipalities of Metropolitan Toronto, Etobicoke, North York, Toronto, East York and Scarborough, as amended, shall remain in force with respect to any lands within the City of Toronto for which approval of the new Official Plan is not granted on the date referred to in Section 2 herein and shall continue in force with respect to such lands until such time as the new Official Plan receives approval under Section 17 of the *Planning Act*, as applied to such lands.

5. The Clerk of the City is hereby authorized and directed to make application to the Minister of Municipal Affairs for approval of the City of Toronto Official Plan, attached hereto as Schedule "A".
