BY-LAW No. 13-2004

To amend By-law No. 43-2000 to extend the expiration of Part Lot Control exemption for certain lands found within the lands commonly known as Phase II of the Woodbine Park Development.

WHEREAS authority is given to Council by Section 50(7.4) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13, as amended, to pass this By-law;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Section 2 of By-law No. 43-2000 is deleted and the following is substituted for it:

Pursuant to the provisions of Subsection 50(7.3) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13, as amended, this By-law expires as of December 31, 2005.

2. This By-law applies to the lands described in the attached Schedule "A".
