**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 51-2004**

**To amend By-law No. 21184 regarding the heritage designation of 90 Morningside Avenue.**

WHEREAS by By-law No. 21184 (of the former City of Scarborough) the property located at 90 Morningside Avenue, known as the "Purvis/Castle Log House", was designated as being of architectural and historical value or interest under Part IV of the *Ontario Heritage Act*; and

WHEREAS a portion of the designated property, which is owned by the City of Toronto, has been declared surplus, and the historic house is now located on Part 1 on Reference Plan 66R-20609; and

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Toronto has caused to be served upon the owners of the lands and premises, and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation, notice of its intention to repeal, in part, By-law No. 21184 and has caused such notice of intention to be published in a newspaper having general circulation in accordance with the provisions of the *Ontario Heritage Act*; and

WHEREAS no notice of objection to the said proposed amendment has been served upon the City Clerk;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule "A" of By-law No. 21184 is amended by deleting the legal description of the lands contained therein and replacing it with the following:  
  
"The lands described as Part 1 on Reference Plan 66R-20609".
2. The City Solicitor is hereby authorised to cause a copy of this by-law to be registered against title to the property currently subject to By-law No. 21184.
3. The City Clerk is hereby authorised to cause a copy of this by-law to be published and served in accordance with the provisions of Part IV of the *Ontario Heritage Act*.
