BY-LAW No. 54-2004

To layout and dedicate certain land west of Keele Street for public highway purposes to form part of the public highway The Pond Road.

Whereas the City will be acquiring land for the proposed public highway The Pond Road in connection with a site plan agreement registered as Instrument TR050320 with York University and as a condition of completing a number of related transactions York University has required the dedication of these lands pending completion of the transactions;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land west of Keele Street to form part of the public highway The Pond Road, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

Part of PIN 10245-0047 (LT).

Part of Lot 23, Concession 4, west of Yonge Street, designated as PARTS 8, 15 and 16 on Plan 66R-20809 in the Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66) in the City of Toronto (formerly the City of North York) and Province of Ontario is laid out and dedicated for public highway purposes to form part of The Pond Road.

2. Section 1 of this By-law does not come into effect until the conveyances to the City of the lands described in Section 1 and the necessary land registrations respecting those conveyances are completed.
