BY-LAW No. 56-2004

To permanently close a portion of the Eastern Avenue Diversion, at the rear of Premises No. 68 Broadview Avenue.

WHEREAS it is recommended that the portion of the Eastern Avenue Diversion, at the rear of Premises No. 68 Broadview Avenue be permanently closed as a public highway and be sold to the abutting owner upon the terms and conditions set out in Clause No. 41 of Toronto East York Community Council Report No. 9, as adopted by City Council at its meeting held on September 22, 23, 24 and 25, 2003; and

WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close the said portion of highway was posted on the notices page of the City's web site in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 162 and no one appeared to address the Toronto South Community Council at its meeting held on January 5, 2004;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The portion of the Eastern Avenue Diversion, at the rear of Premises No. 68 Broadview Avenue, described as follows:

Part of PIN 21077-0133 (LT).

Being Part of Lot 15, Broken Front Concession, Township of York, being part of the Eastern Avenue Diversion, designated as Part 1 on Plan 66R-20464 in the Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66) in the City of Toronto is hereby permanently closed as a public highway.
