BY-LAW No. 77-2004

To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation of traffic on former Metropolitan Roads, with regards to Albion Road and Islington Avenue.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule XV (Prohibited Turns) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

Albion Road and the westerly access to Nos. 1104 and 1130 Albion Road, located 140 metres west of Islington Avenue (M.T. 11)	Eastbound and Southbound	Left	Anytime
Albion Road and the westerly access to Nos. 1104 and 1130 Albion Road, located 140 metres west of Islington Avenue (M.T. 11)	Westbound	Right	Anytime
Islington Avenue and the Islington Avenue access to Nos. 1104 and 1130 Albion Road (M.T. 63)	Eastbound and Northbound	Left	Anytime
