BY-LAW No. 83-2004

To amend Municipal Code Chapter 636, Public Squares, by deleting § 636-23, which delegated the approval of exceptions from certain restrictions on the use of Nathan Phillips Square during the 2003 election period.

WHEREAS By-law No. 821-2003, "To amend Municipal Code Chapter 636, Public Squares, to delegate the approval of exceptions from certain restrictions on the use of Nathan Phillips Square during the election period." enacted § 636-23, Delegation during election period; and

WHEREAS the Administration Committee held its first regular meeting on January 9, 2004; and

WHEREAS the City Solicitor is authorized to introduce a bill in Council to delete the amendment made by By-law No. 821-2003 after the election period;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 636, Public Squares, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended by deleting § 636-23.
