**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 129-2004**

**To amend further By-law No. 15-92 of the former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto  
respecting pensions and other benefits.**

WHEREAS By-law No. 15-92 of the former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto, a by-law  
“To provide pensions for employees, their spouses and children of the Metropolitan Corporation  
and other participating employers”, as heretofore amended, governs the Metropolitan Toronto  
Pension Plan; and

WHEREAS it is desired to make the entitlement to the cost-of-living increase for 2003 provided for  
in section 42.12 of that By-law as enacted by By-law No. 759-2003 effective as of the 1st day of  
January, 2003;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law No. 759-2003 is amended by adding thereto the following section:
  4. Except for section 3, which shall be deemed to have come into force on the  
1st day of January, 2003, this by-law shall come into force on the day of its  
enactment and passage.
2. This by-law shall be deemed to have come into force on the 24th day of July, 2003.

ENACTED AND PASSED by an affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of the Members of Council  
present and voting this 29th day of January, A.D. 2004.
