BY-LAW No. 178-2004

To amend Municipal Code Chapter 103, Heritage, to increase the number of citizen appointees on the Toronto Preservation Board from five to seven.

WHEREAS Chapter 103, Heritage, Article III, Preservation Board; Community Preservation Panels, § 103–17, Toronto Preservation Board, provides that the Board shall consist of the Chair or designate of each panel, five citizens to be appointed by Council and up to three members of Council; and

WHEREAS as a result of the reduction of the number of community councils from six to four, representation on the Toronto Preservation Board by representatives from community preservation panels has decreased from fourteen to twelve; and

WHEREAS it is desirable to maintain the number of Toronto Preservation Board members at fourteen;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Section 103–17B(1) of Chapter 103, Heritage, Article III, Preservation Board; Community Preservation Panels of the Municipal Code is amended by deleting the word "five" and substituting the word "seven".
