BY-LAW No. 192-2004

To amend further By-law No. 92-93, a by-law “To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York”, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, regarding Aerodrome Crescent, Brian Peck Crescent, Lumley Avenue, Moore Avenue, Thomas Elgie Drive and Vanderhoof Avenue.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- Schedule VIII (No Parking) of By-law No. 92-93, entitled “To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York”, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is further amended by inserting in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4, in alphabetical order by highway name in Column 1 of the said Schedule, the following:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times & Days)
Aerodrome Crescent	Both	East and west intersections with Vanderhoof Avenue	Anytime
Vanderhoof Avenue	East and North	The easterly limit of Brentcliffe Road and the northerly limit of Research Road	Anytime

- Schedule XIX (Compulsory Stops) of By-law No. 92-93, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is further amended by inserting in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule, in alphabetical order by intersection name in Column 1 of the said Schedule, the following:

Aerodrome Crescent and Vanderhoof Avenue	Aerodrome Crescent (east and west intersections with Vanderhoof Avenue)
Brian Peck Crescent and Aerodrome Crescent	Brian Peck Crescent (westbound)
Brian Peck Crescent and Vanderhoof Avenue	Brian Peck Crescent (southbound)
Lumley Avenue and Moore Avenue	Lumley Avenue (northbound)
Moore Avenue and Lumley Avenue	Moore Avenue (eastbound and westbound)
