CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 211-2004

To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 400, Traffic and Parking, respecting Algarve Crescent.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, of the former City of Toronto is amended as follows:

A. By inserting in Schedule I (One-Way Highways) in § 400-54, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Algarve Crescent	Old Weston Road and Turnberry Avenue	Anytime	Westbound/southbound

B. By deleting from Schedule XXIII (No Parking Certain Times) in § 400-76, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1)	(From Column 2)	(From Column 3)	(From Column 4)
Algarve Crescent	North and West	Turnberry Avenue and a point 38 metres west of Old Weston Road	Anytime

C. By inserting in Schedule XXIII (No Parking Certain Times) in § 400-76, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Algarve Crescent	South and East	Turnberry Avenue and Old Weston Road	Anytime
