BY-LAW No. 216-2004

**To amend City of Toronto By-law No. 189-2003, as amended by By-law No. 563-2003,
being a By-law to effect Interim Control Areas in the Coulter Avenue/King Street Area and
the King Street Crescent/Little Avenue Area of the City in the former City of York.**

WHEREAS authority is given to Council by Section 38 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13, as amended, to pass an Interim Control By-law, for a period of time which shall not exceed one year from the date of passage of the By-law; and

WHEREAS Council on April 15, 2003 passed By-law No. 189-2003 to effect Interim Control in the Coulter Avenue/King Street Area and the King Street Crescent/Little Avenue Area of the City for a period of one year from the date of its passing; and

WHEREAS authority is given to Council by Section 38 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13, as amended, to extend the period of time during which an Interim Control By-law is to be in effect, provided the total period of time does not exceed two years from the date of the passing of the Interim Control By-law;

THEREFORE the Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. That section 4 of the City of Toronto By-law No. 189-2003, as amended by By-law No. 563-2003, be further amended by deleting the words “for a period of one year from the date of its passing” and replacing them with the words “until April 14, 2005”.
