BY-LAW No. 226-2004

**To authorize the alteration of intersecting streets along College Street, between
Montrose Avenue and Gladstone Avenue by narrowing them.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The following alterations are authorized:

The narrowing of intersecting streets along College Street, between Montrose Avenue and Gladstone Avenue as set out below, generally as shown on Drawing No. 421F-7241, dated February 2004:

- (a) Montrose Avenue, on the east side, from College Street to a point 9.0 metres north thereof, and on the east side, from College Street to a point 9.0 metres south thereof;
- (b) Crawford Street, on the east side, from College Street to a point 9.0 metres north thereof;
- (c) Shaw Street, on the east side, from College Street to a point 9.0 metres north thereof, and on the east side, from College Street to a point 9.0 metres south thereof;
- (d) Roxton Road, on the west side, from College Street to a point 9.0 metres north thereof, and on the west side, from College Street to a point 9.0 metres south thereof;
- (e) Concord Avenue, on the west side, from College Street to a point 9.0 metres north thereof;
- (f) Delaware Avenue, on the east side, from College Street to a point 9.0 metres north thereof;
- (g) Rusholme Road, on the east side, from College Street to a point 9.0 metres north thereof;
- (h) Havelock Street, on the east side, from College Street to a point 9.0 metres north thereof; and

- (i) Gladstone Avenue, on the east side, from College Street to a point 9.0 metres north thereof.
