BY-LAW No. 265-2004

To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 109-86, respecting maximum rates of speed on certain former Metropolitan Roads, regarding Don Valley Parkway.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule I of Metropolitan By-law No. 109-86, as amended, being a By-law "To prescribe maximum rates of speed on certain Metropolitan Roads", is further amended by striking out the words and figures:

Don Valley Parkway (M.T. 201), northbound and southbound, 90 kilometres per hour between the Frederick G. Gardiner Expressway and Highway No. 404

where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)
Don Valley Parkway (M.T. 201), northbound, between the Frederick G. Gardiner Expressway and a point approximately 83 metres south of Three Valleys Drive/Brookbanks Drive	90 kilometres per hour
Don Valley Parkway (M.T. 201), northbound, between a point approximately 83 metres south of Three Valleys Drive/Brookbanks Drive and the property line between the Don Valley Parkway and Highway No. 404, approximately 19 metres north of Underpass Gate	60 kilometres per hour
Don Valley Parkway (M.T. 201), southbound, between the Frederick G. Gardiner Expressway and a point approximately 52 metres north of Three Valleys Drive/Brookbanks Drive	90 kilometres per hour
Don Valley Parkway (M.T. 201), southbound, between a point approximately 52 metres north of Three Valleys Drive/Brookbanks Drive and the property line between the Don Valley Parkway and Highway No. 404, approximately 16 metres north of Underpass Gate	60 kilometres per hour

2. This by-law shall be effective commencing on or about April 24, 2004.
