CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 267-2004

To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation of traffic on former Metropolitan Roads, regarding Leslie Street, Lesmill Road, McNairn Avenue and Yonge Street.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule XIII (One-Way Traffic Lanes) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)	(In Column 5)
Leslie Street and Lesmill Road/eastbound Highway 401 off-ramp	The southerly limit of Lesmill Road and a point 70 metres south thereof	Easterly Northbound	Anytime	Northbound right-turning (buses excepted)

2. Schedule XV (Prohibited Turns) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by striking out the words and figures:

Yonge Street and McNairn Avenue (M.T. 29)	Northbound	Left	Anytime
Yonge Street and McNairn Avenue (M.T. 29)	Southbound	Right	Anytime

where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
