BY-LAW No. 272-2004

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 447, Fences, to exempt a portion of the fence on the property municipally known as 2085 Islington Avenue from the maximum height requirements.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Section 447-5 of Chapter 447, Fences, of the City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended by adding the following after the last section:

The proposed open wrought iron grille fence to be located along the north property line (being the front yard) of the property known municipally in 2004 as 2085 Islington Avenue, measuring between 1.83 and 2.10 metres in height and extending approximately 115 metres in length, along with concrete pillar supports measuring approximately 2.8 metres in height, may be retained despite the height restriction of 1.2 metres for such fences in § 447-2B(1), and the proposed open wrought iron grille fence to be located along the west property line (being the flankage yard), measuring between 1.83 and 2.10 metres in height and extending approximately 165 metres in length, along with concrete pillar supports measuring approximately 2.8 metres in height and extending approximately 165 metres in length, along with concrete pillar supports measuring approximately 2.8 metres in height restriction of 2 metres for such fences in § 447-2B(1).
