BY-LAW No. 284-2004

To authorize the alterations of Victoria Park Avenue, Blantyre Avenue, Courcelette Road and Fallingbrook Road by the installation of speed humps.

WHEREAS the following speed hump polls of households were conducted pursuant to the City's Traffic Calming Policy:

- (i) Victoria Park Avenue, between Queen Street East and Bracken Avenue;
- (ii) Blantyre Avenue, between Windsor Avenue and Kingston Road;
- (iii) Courcelette Road, between Windsor Avenue and Kingston Road; and
- (iv) Fallingbrook Road, between Windsor Avenue and Kingston Road; and

WHEREAS by letter dated March 16, 2004 Transportation Services, East District, reported to Councillor Brian Ashton that the poll results were favourable. Conditions for the installations of speed humps on the subject sections of Victoria Park Avenue, Blantyre Avenue, Courcelette Road and Fallingbrook Road, have therefore been satisfied;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The following alterations are authorized:

The construction of 19 speed humps on:

- (i) Victoria Park Avenue, between Queen Street East and Bracken Avenue;
- (ii) Blantyre Avenue, between Windsor Avenue and Kingston Road;
- (iii) Courcelette Road, between Windsor Avenue and Kingston Road; and
- (iv) Fallingbrook Road, between Windsor Avenue and Kingston Road;

generally as shown on Drawing No. D03-586 (Fallingbrook Community), dated April, 2003.
