CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 299-2004

To amend General Zoning By-law No. 438-86 of the former City of Toronto with respect to lands known municipally in the year 2003 as 70 St. Clements Avenue.

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Toronto has been requested to amend its zoning by-law under section 34 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13, as amended, respecting the land municipally known in the year 2003 as 70 St. Clements Avenue; and

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Toronto conducted a public meeting under section 34 of the *Planning Act* regarding the proposed zoning by-law amendment; and

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Toronto, at its meeting held April 15 and 16, 2004, determined to amend Zoning By-law No. 438-86, as amended, for the former City of Toronto;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. Former City of Toronto By-law No. 438-86, "A By-law to regulate the use of land and the erection, use, bulk, height, spacing of and other matters relating to buildings and structures and to prohibit certain uses of lands and the erection and use of certain buildings and structures in various areas of the City of Toronto.", as amended, is amended as follows:
 - (1) Section 12(1) is amended by adding the following exception:
 - "460. to prevent the use of a cemetery within the area outlined by a heavy lines on the Map at the end of and forming part of this exception, being a courtyard within an existing *place of worship*, on lands known municipally in the year 2003 as 70 St. Clements Avenue, if the cemetery is used only for the interment and scattering of cremated human remains."
