CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 322-2004

To layout and dedicate certain land on the east side of Mutual Street, north of Carlton Street, for public highway purposes to form part of the public highway Mutual Street.

WHEREAS the City is the owner of certain land acquired in connection with Site Plan Approval respecting 281 Mutual Street;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land on the east side of Mutual Street, north of Carlton Street, described by W. Kowalenko, City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

Part of PIN 21105-0068 (LT).

Parts of Lots A, 1, 2, 3 and 4 on Plan D17 designated as PART 1 on Plan 66R-19823 in the Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66) in the City of Toronto and Province of Ontario is laid out and dedicated for public highway purposes.
