## BY-LAW No. 336-2004

## To amend Municipal Code Chapter 441, Fees, to establish fees for certain services provided by Municipal Licensing and Standards Division staff.

WHEREAS under section 391 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, a municipality may pass by-laws imposing fees or charges on any class of persons for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of it; and

WHEREAS the Policy and Finance Committee held a public meeting on February 24, 2004, in accordance with the *Municipal Act*, 2001, and notice of the proposed draft by-law was posted on the City's web site for a minimum of 4 days;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- **1.** Chapter 441, Fees, of the City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended by deleting Subsection 441-6Q and substituting the following:
  - Q. The fees and rates set out in Column 2 below are hereby established for the provision of the services listed opposite under Column 1 below:

R. The fees and charges contained in this section are exclusive of taxes, which shall be added where applicable.

PRELIMINARY PROJECT REVIEW — A detailed review of a proposal to determine its compliance with the City's zoning by-laws, Municipal Codes and other regulations, and to indicate other approvals that are required prior to the issuance of a building permit, sign permit or business licence.

PROPOSAL — A proposal to develop or redevelop land or to sever land or to construct, alter, add to or extend buildings or structures, or to erect or modify signs, or obtain a business licence.
