CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 380-2004

To layout and dedicate certain land for public highway purposes to form part of the public highway Leaffield Drive South (Scarborough-Agincourt, Ward 40).

WHEREAS the City has acquired certain lands as hereinafter described and the Council of the City deems it appropriate and necessary to accept the said lands as Public Highway; and

WHEREAS subsection 1 of Section 31, of the *Municipal Act*, S.O. 2001, c. 25 provides that the Council of every municipality may pass by-laws for establishing and laying out highways;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The lands described as Part of Lot 8 on Plan 3699 designated as Parts 3 and 4 on Plan 66R-20837 and Part of Block 13 on Plan 66M-2342, in the City of Toronto (formerly City of Scarborough), more particularly described in Schedule "A" attached hereto, which forms part of this By-law, are hereby established and laid out as a public highway within the City to be known as Leaffield Drive South.
2. All By-laws presently in force with respect to highways and streets shall apply to the said highways created under this By-law.
