**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 382-2004**

**To layout and dedicate certain land for public highway purposes to form part of the public highway Birchmount Road (Scarborough Southwest, Ward 36).**

WHEREAS the City has acquired certain lands as hereinafter described and the Council of the City deems it appropriate and necessary to accept the said lands as Public Highway; and

WHEREAS subsection 1 of Section 31, of the *Municipal Act*, S.O. 2001, c. 25 provides that the Council of every municipality may pass by-laws for establishing and laying out highways;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The lands described as Parts 1 and 2 on Plan 66R-196, in the City of Toronto (formerly City of Scarborough), more particularly described in Schedule "A" attached hereto, which forms part of this By-law, are hereby established and laid out as a public highway within the City to be known as Birchmount Road.
2. All By-laws presently in force with respect to highways and streets shall apply to the said highways created under this By-law.
