BY-LAW No. 384-2004

To permanently close to vehicular and pedestrian traffic a portion of the public lane extending easterly from Pembroke Street between Premises Nos. 73 and 77 Pembroke Street.

WHEREAS it is recommended that a portion of the public lane extending easterly from Pembroke Street between Premises Nos. 73 and 77 Pembroke Street be permanently closed to vehicular and pedestrian traffic; and

WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close the said portion of lane was posted on the notices page of the City's web site in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 162 and no one appeared to address the Toronto South Community Council at its meeting held on May 4, 2004;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The portion of the public lane extending easterly from Pembroke Street between Premises Nos. 73 and 77 Pembroke Street, described as follows, is hereby permanently closed to pedestrian and vehicular traffic:

Part of PIN 21100-0162 (LT).

Part of the Public Lane on Plan 150, designated as PART 1 on Plan 66R-20605 in the Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66) in the City of Toronto and Province of Ontario.
