BY-LAW No. 396-2004

To amend further By-law No. 92-93, a by-law “To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York”, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, regarding Brentcliffe Road.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule XIII (One-Way Traffic Lanes) of By-law No. 92-93, entitled “To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York”, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is further amended by inserting in Columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the said Schedule after the words “Bermondsey Road” where they appear in Column 1 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1 Road)	(In Column 2 Between)	(In Column 3 Lanes)	(In Column 4 Time or Days)	(In Column 5 Direction)
Brentcliffe Road	A point 30.5 metres south of Eglinton Avenue East and Vanderhoof Avenue	Easterly Northbound	Anytime	Northbound right-turning
