**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 397-2004**

**To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation of traffic on former Metropolitan Roads, regarding Brentcliffe Road and Eglinton Avenue East.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule VI (Prohibited Pedestrian Crossings) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by striking out the following words and figures where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule:

Eglinton Avenue East (M.T. 18)	Between the west curb line of Brentcliffe Road and a point 30.5 Metres east of the east street line of Brentcliffe Road

2. Schedule XIII (One-Way Traffic Lanes) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by striking out the words and figures:

Eglinton Avenue East and Brentcliffe Road (M.T. 18)	Brentcliffe Road and a point 30.5 metres west thereof	Southerly Eastbound	Anytime	Eastbound right-turning (buses excepted)

where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the said Schedule and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
