BY-LAW No. 405-2004

To rename part of the public highway Livingston Road as “Livingston Road North”.

WHEREAS notice of the proposed enactment of the draft by-law was posted on the City of Toronto web site from April 27, 2004 to May 3, 2004, and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on May 4, 2004, and it is appropriate to rename part of the public highway Livingston Road as “Livingston Road North”;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Part of the public highway Livingston Road described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

PIN 06376-0265 (LT).

Part of the public highway Livingston Road being part of the Road Allowance between Lots 14 and 15 in Concession D lying north of a line drawn from the north easterly angle of PART 1 on Plan 64R-9345 and the south westerly angle of PART 3 of Plan 64R-7226, and lying south of the easterly production of the north limit of PART 4 on Plan 64R-4026 in the Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66) in the City of Toronto (formerly the city of Scarborough) and Province of Ontario is renamed “Livingston Road North”.
