BY-LAW No. 430-2004

To authorize the alteration of Rustic Road, between Culford Road and Keele Street, by the installation of speed humps.

WHEREAS a speed hump poll of households on Rustic Road, between Culford Road and Keele Street was conducted and, notwithstanding that the polling criteria for the installation of speed humps pursuant to the City's Traffic Calming Policy was not satisfied, Humber York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Rustic Road;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The following alteration is authorized:

The construction of speed humps on Rustic Road, between Culford Road and Keele Street, generally as shown on Drawing No. NY-1454, on file in the office of the Manager, Traffic Operations, District Three, Transportation Services.
