BY-LAW No. 434-2004

To authorize the alteration of Gledhill Avenue, between Danforth Avenue and Cosburn Avenue, by the installation of twelve speed humps.

WHEREAS a speed hump poll of households on Gledhill Avenue, between Danforth Avenue and Cosburn Avenue was conducted, the polling criteria for the section of Gledhill Avenue, between Lumsden Avenue and Cosburn Avenue, did satisfy the polling criteria for the installation of speed humps pursuant to the City's Traffic Calming Policy and the Toronto South Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps along the entire section of Gledhill Avenue, between Danforth Avenue and Cosburn Avenue;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The following alteration is authorized:

The construction of speed humps on Gledhill Avenue, between Danforth Avenue and Cosburn Avenue, generally as shown on Drawing No. 421F-7213, dated December, 2003 on file in the office of the Senior Traffic Investigator, South District, Transportation Services.
