BY-LAW No. 481-2004

To amend Chapter 215 of the former City of Etobicoke Municipal Code, as amended, and to amend former City of Etobicoke By-law No. 1991-94, as amended, to dissolve the Sign Variance Advisory Committee.

WHEREAS the former City of Etobicoke Council enacted and passed By-law No. 1991-94 on May 27, 1991, to establish the Sign Variance Advisory Committee; and

WHEREAS the former City of Etobicoke Council enacted and passed By-law No. 1993-189 on October 18, 1994, amending Chapter 215 of the former City of Etobicoke Municipal Code, to provide that there be deputations for minor variances for signs at meetings of the Sign Variance Advisory Committee pursuant to § 215-8C(3); and

WHEREAS it is considered necessary and desirable that the former City of Etobicoke's Sign Variance Advisory Committee be dissolved; and

WHEREAS Subsection 11(1)(7) of the *Municipal Act, 2001* grants the City of Toronto authority to pass by-laws respecting structures, including fences and signs;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. Section 1 of the former City of Etobicoke By-law No. 1991-94, as amended, being a by-law 'To amend Chapter 215 of the Municipal Code with Respect to Signs', is repealed.
- **2.** Chapter 215, 'Signs', of the former City of Etobicoke Municipal Code, as amended, is further amended as follows:
 - A. By deleting from § 215-8C(3) the following:

"On receipt of an application and payment of fees in accordance with the foregoing, the Committee Secretary shall arrange for a deputation during a regularly scheduled meeting of the Sign Variance Advisory Committee and shall notify the applicant or any other person expressing an interest in the application of the date and time of the meeting,"

and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

"On receipt of an application and payment of fees in accordance with the foregoing, the Committee Secretary of the Etobicoke York Community Council shall arrange that the application be considered at a regularly scheduled meeting of the Etobicoke York Community Council and shall notify the applicant or any other person expressing an interest in the application of the date and time of the meeting."
