**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 496-2004**

**To amend further By-law No. 1994-0716 of the former Corporation of the  
City of Toronto respecting the provision of assistance to certain firefighters' surviving  
spouses and children.**

WHEREAS By-law No. 1994-0716 of the former Corporation of the City of Toronto, a by-law  
"To reenact Section 16 of By-law No. 305-67 to provide assistance to certain firefighters'  
surviving spouse and children", as heretofore amended, provides for rates of monetary aid as of  
January 1, 1997; and

WHEREAS it is desired to provide for annual increases in such aid commencing  
January 1, 1998;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law No. 1994-0716 of the City's predecessor The Corporation of the City of Toronto,  
as heretofore amended, is further amended by adding thereto the following section:
  - "2. At the beginning of each calendar year, commencing January 1, 1998, the amount  
of each monthly payment due under section 1 shall be increased by such  
percentage increase as has taken place, if any, in the Canada All-Item Consumer  
Price Index over the 12-month period ending on October 31 of the previous  
calendar year."
2. (1) Subject to subsection (2), this by-law shall come into force on the date of  
its enactment and passing.
  - (2) Section 1 shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of  
January, 1998.
  - (3) For each person to whom section 2 of said By-law No. 1994-0716 applies,  
the increases payable thereunder for the period preceding the date on  
which the first increased payment pursuant to that section is paid in 2004  
shall be paid to the person without interest as soon thereafter as is  
convenient.
