BY-LAW No. 502-2004

**To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 400, Traffic and Parking,
respecting Cavell Avenue, Craven Road, Marion Street, Rathnelly Avenue,
Wheeler Avenue and Wolfrey Avenue.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, of the former City of Toronto is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule XXXVIII (Designated On-Street Parking for Disabled Person Parking Permit Holders) in § 400-91, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

Cavell Avenue	North	A point 21.5 metres east of Pape Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further east thereof	Anytime
Marion Street	South	A point 9.0 metres east of Roncesvalles Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further east	Anytime
Rathnelly Avenue	West	A point 31.0 metres north of MacPherson Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further north	Anytime

B. By inserting in Schedule XXXVIII (Designated On-Street Parking for Disabled Person Parking Permit Holders) in § 400-91, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Cavell Avenue	North	A point 29.2 metres east of Pape Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further east	Anytime
Craven Road	East	A point 67.5 metres south of Gerrard Street East and a point 5.5 metres further south	Anytime
Wheeler Avenue	East	A point 223 metres north of Queen Street East and a point 5.5 metres further north	Anytime
