BY-LAW No. 512-2004

To layout and dedicate certain land for public highway purposes to form part of the public highway Eglinton Avenue West at Almeda Avenue.

WHEREAS the City is the owner of certain land acquired in connection with the approval of Site Plan Control Application No. TC SPC 2001-0043 respecting 1531-1535 Eglinton Avenue West;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land to form part of the public highway Eglinton Avenue West at Almeda Avenue, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

Part of PIN 10451-0141 (LT).

Being parts of Lots 112 and 113 on Plan 1687 designated as PARTS 1, 2 and 3 on Plan 66R-19890 in the Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66) in the City of Toronto (formerly in the City of York) and Province of Ontario is laid out and dedicated for public highway purposes to form part of the public highway Eglinton Avenue West.
