BY-LAW No. 515-2004

To rename the public highway Roots Circle as “Raponi Circle”.

WHEREAS notice of the proposed enactment of the draft by-law was posted on the City of Toronto web site from June 1, 2004 to June 7, 2004, and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on June 8, 2004, and it is appropriate to rename the public highway Roots Circle as “Raponi Circle”;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The public highway Roots Circle described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

PIN 06053-3317 (LT).

Roots Circle on Plan 66M2407 in the Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66) in the City of Toronto (formerly the City of Scarborough) and Province of Ontario is renamed “Raponi Circle”.
